


Year 1 Summer Term 2 Curriculum Newsletter




This term we will be learning about changes to our lives as we grow up, this includes changes to our  bodies.

What are we learning?

In **Maths** we are going to be exploring money, multiplication and division, and volume and capacity.



In **English** we will be looking at different stories about wild animals including Rumble in the Jungle, Monkey Puzzle and The Tiger who Came for Tea. We will also look at the human body through the book Funny bones. This will include looking at rhyming words in sentences, retelling the stories and drawing story maps. We will write a recount after our trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park and write them a letter to say thank you.



In **Science**, we will focus on identifying and naming different animals including carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will also look at naming and labelling different parts of the human body and the senses that go with different parts.



Topic Overview

This half term our topic is 'Living things'



We will be visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park. We will then identify and classify animals based on whether they have fur, feathers or scales.

RE


We will look at Ramadan, Eid, and the importance of this to Muslims.



Geography


We will be locating and naming the 4 UK countries on a map including looking at different landmarks.

We will also look at different countries that have hot and cold climates and which different animals that live in these countries.




During this term the children will also take part in some transition days to help the move into Year 2 in September.


Spreading My Wings from Year 1 to Year 2

How can you help at home?

- Take your child to see different types of animals.

- Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
