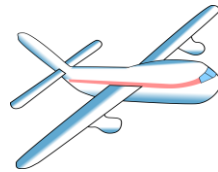

## I should already know:

## This will help me in the future:

You need to talk about holidays in 3 tenses (past, present, future) as a GCSE topic.

## Forming the perfect tense:

We use the perfect tense to talk about events which occurred in the past. It lets us talk about what we did or have done.

This tense uses the following elements:

- 1) The correct form of **haben** or **sein** in the present tense, to tell us who we are referring to. We call this an **auxiliary verb** when we use it to form the perfect tense.
- 2) A **past participle**. For many **regular** verbs, this is formed by adding **ge-** at the start of the verb, removing the **-en** from the infinitive, and adding a **-t** at the end.  
e.g wohnen → ~~ge-wohnen~~ + t → gewohnt.  
machen → ~~ge-machen~~ + t → gemacht.

The **auxiliary verb (haben or sein)** must be the **2<sup>nd</sup> idea**.  
The **past participle** always goes to the **end** of the sentence.

- e.g Ich **habe** in Deutschland **gewohnt**.  
= I lived in Germany / I have lived in Germany.  
e.g Sie **hat** die Hausaufgaben **gemacht**.  
= She did / She has done the homework.



## Vocabulary Do's and Don't's:

### Do:

- Practice little and often!
- Use a range of different practice techniques!
- Pay attention to spelling, accents and capital letters - these matter!
- Learn the genders of nouns (masculine, feminine or neuter) and not just the words.
- Think about how words are pronounced - would you recognise it if you heard it?

### Don't:

- Only practice in the same order as on the page - you need to recognise the words in any order!
- Try to cram - last minute learning doesn't work for languages!
- Forget to think about what tense the vocabulary is in.
