

#### Aspect 6 – Oral blending and segmenting


Let's turn sounds into words.

We are only going to focus on these sounds;

**'s, a, t, p, i, n'**

Here are a few words you can use to sound out to your children.

sat, pin, nip, pat, tap, pit, pip and sound them out.

Then the children will say "sat"
