


Miss Haimeed's group

Focus: Rhyming



These are designed to support your child.

Miss Haimeed has put together some activities for you to try, alongside the other learning opportunities posted on the OADV website.

The aim is to do the activities over one week (please do not do them all at once)

<p>Practise the nursery rhymes the children are less familiar with, can you practice some of the rhymes with your children?</p> <p>Consider using actions to help them remember e.g. 1,2,3,4,5 show fingers and pretend to count.</p>	<p>See below</p>	<p>Video of you singing the nursery rhymes</p>	<p>Date completed:</p> <p>Rate how it went:</p> 
<p>Hickory, Dickory, Dock</p> <p>Ask your sibling to stand and pretend to be a tall clock. As you sing the song pretend to be the mouse and run around the clock.</p> <p>“Hickory dickory dock the mouse ran up the clock” (point to the top of your sibling)</p> <p>“The clock struck one” (child who is clock to show number 1 using fingers)</p> <p>“The mouse ran down” (child to go low like a tiny mouse at the side of their sibling who is pretending to be a clock)</p>	<p>A sibling can join in with you, or your adult.</p>	<p>Send Miss Haimeed a video of you acting out the actions for your nursery rhyme (this can just be you on your own)</p>	<p>Date completed:</p> <p>Rate how it went:</p> 
<p>Can you draw a picture of two clocks...?</p>  <p>On one clock draw the mouse running up.</p>	<p>Pens and paper</p>	<p>Send Miss Haimeed a picture of your work</p>	<p>Date completed:</p> <p>Rate how it went:</p> 

<p>On the other clock draw the mouse running down.</p> <p>Extra challenge: can you draw the arrows for up and down on your picture?</p>			
<p>Questions to ask your children around the rhyming songs.</p> <p>How can we catch fish?</p> <p>Where do fish live?</p> <p>How can we look after fish?</p> <p>What does alive mean?</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Practice drawing your numbers 1-5 and then draw your fish underneath?</p> <p>Can you draw a fishing hook or net?</p>	<p>Comfy space to talk about some of the animals in the nursery rhymes e.g. make a den with cushions.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Pens and paper required for your drawing</p>	<p>Show Miss Haimeed your fishing hook design</p>	<p>Date completed:</p> <p>Rate how it went:</p>
