English

In English, the children will be basing their writing on the seaside and adventures at sea.

The children will experience writing in a range of genres, including:

- Novel writing
- Newspaper articles
- Diary entries
- Fact files

Geography

In Geography, the children will locate the United Kingdom on a world map and identify the four countries (England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland) that make up the United Kingdom.

In addition, the children will begin to identify flags of countries and identify their capital cities and famous landmarks.

Maths

In maths, the children will be identifying the properties and values of coins and notes, compare different amounts of money and find the costs of items using addition and subtraction.

In addition, the children will engage in multiplication and division in a range of contexts. Within this topic, they will be introduced to arrays.

Finally, the children will explore measuring capacity and volume using non-standard and standard units of measure and apply their fraction knowledge within this context.

Science

In Science, the children will be identifying a range of everyday materials, including:

- metal
- plastic
- wood
- fabric
- glass

The children will discuss and compare the material's physical properties.

Art

In Art, the children will learn about four artists from around the UK and ask questions about their work.
