

## Under the Sea

### English

In English, we will be using the story 'Flotsam' to help us write our own narrative about animals that live under the sea. Flotsam is a wordless book with some wonderful pictures that will help us create our own story! We will also use the story Dougal's Deep Sea diary to write our own diaries about a deep sea diving experience. Look on the Academy website for your weekly lessons.



### SPaG

In SPaG, we will be consolidating our writing by recapping subordinating and coordinating conjunctions, writing in past and present tense, word classes and sentence types.

### Maths

On Time Tables Rock Stars you will be assigned the time tables 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s to consolidate your timetable knowledge as well as trying out the 4x table. Who will become a Rock Hero? Also check your Mathletics account to see what units your teachers have set you to do.

Find your weekly maths lessons on the Academy website where we will look at exploring the four calculations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

### Geography

In geography, we will be able to recall the five different oceans and seven continents of the world. We will look at identifying them on maps to build our knowledge of the world around us. We will also compare the differences between mainland and an island.

### Science

In science, we will be learning to identify a range of plants and animals that live under the sea. We will categorise (sort) these animals based on the type of animal they are (fish, mammal or mollusk). We will also be exploring food chains of these animals to help us identify whether the animals eat plants or other animals.
