


Key Words

Word	Definition
Habitat	the natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or living thing
Animal	a living thing that eats, breathes oxygen and moves
Minibeast	a small animal without a backbone, such as an insect or spider
Lifecycle	a series of changes in the life of a living thing e.g. being born, growing
Innovate	to change something
Hatch	when an egg breaks open to produce a young animal e.g. chick






Maths


