


### Science

**Challenge:** Name the gases in the air you are breathing.




### History

### Music

In music, we are learning about different composers. Edward Elgar was an English composer who created pieces of music dedicated to different people. Create a piece of music for someone you know and think about the sound you would use for them (e.g. fast sounds if they are running, high sounds if they are happy) Use any instruments you can find (or clapping/humming) and record yourself. Make sure that you explain what you have done at the end!



### Metacognition

Look at your knowledge organiser (you will find this on the Academy website) and represent the key vocabulary in difference ways e.g draw a picture, make a sculpture, take pictures of the words in your house (if possible), use IT to recreate the word etc.



### DT

This half term we are learning to mould clay into a Roman fort. Use a mouldable substance (e.g. salt dough, plasticine, playdoh, clay, sand) to create a Roman artefact. If you do not have any materials which you could mould, design your Roman artefact.
