History

Muhammed Ali was a famous boxer. His birth name was Cassius Marcellus Clay Jr but he changed it to Muhammed when he converted to Islam.

In 1960, Muhammed won the gold medal in the summer Olympics and in 1964 he became the heavyweight champion of the world.



As well as boxing, Muhammed is also famous for supporting civil rights. He campaigned against racism and refused to join the army as he didn't believe it was ethical to fight in a war.

Christians believe that when Jesus was born, King Herod was jealous and afraid of losing his power so he tried to kill Jesus.


To try and kill Jesus, King Herod demanded that all young boys under the age of two were to be killed.


Below are some examples of Islamic art.

This is the icon for word.




You can use a word document for writing.
