Physical features	A naturally created feature on the surface of the Earth such as, mountains.
Climate	The general weather conditions usually found in a particular place.
region	A particular area or part of the world, or any of the large official areas into which a country is divided.

All Christians celebrate **Easter** and **Christmas** as these are important stories within the bible about the birth and death of Jesus Christ.


Art and Design

Cubism is a style of art that uses bright, bold colours and different shapes. It was formed by Picasso as a response to the rapidly changing modern world. Picasso used his observations and memory to put different images and shapes together.

Science



A plant is made up of male and female parts. Both of these parts are needed for a plant to reproduce.



Germination is when a seed begins to grow and roots are formed.

Pollination occurs when pollen is transferred from the anther to the stigma, often by an insect. **Fertilisation** happens when the pollen travels from the **stigma** down the **style** to the **ovary**. The pollen joins with an **ovule** to form a seed. The seed forms inside the ovary.
