Awin for writing an amazing biography about her chosen artist

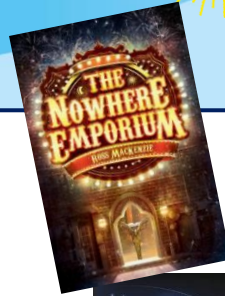



Curriculum overview
