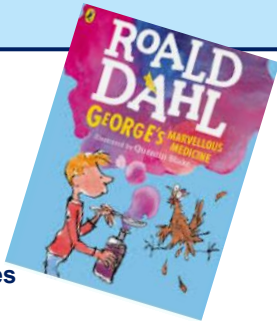




## Curriculum overview
