As you are aware the Academy is keen that all of our children eat a healthy nutritious meal at lunchtime as this is proven to sustain students and help them maintain a level of learning throughout the day. To help parents with this we have subsidised the cost of our school lunches since 2016 unfortunately, due to our increasing student numbers we are no longer able to do this and have to advise that from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November (after the October half-term break) prices will increase to £2.25 per day, £11.25 a week.

Apologies as we have had a few issues with the introduction of our system for online lunch payments for secondary students which we are resolving, we will communicate this to you as soon as we can. In the meantime can we remind all parents that lunches should be paid for in advance and payment can be made by either cash or credit card in our main Reception.

Secondary children should ensure that they have enough money on their accounts to purchase food at break and lunch as required.
