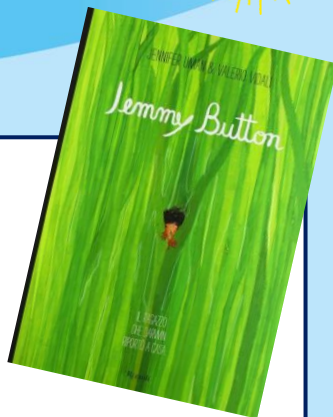




Curriculum overview
