

Curriculum overview



In Science we will be exploring the topic 'Healthy Me'.. Discovering and discussing how to live a healthy lifestyle, diet including nutrients, exercise and the impact of not living healthy lifestyle. We will explore the impact that exercise and drugs can have on our bodies.

In R.E we will explore similarities and differences between different prayer traditions within religions and what prayer reveals about different beliefs.

Maths and English

This term, we will be reading 'The Viking Boy' by Tony Bradman. Children will produce a narrative piece of writing and non-chronological report. They will focus on using literacy devices to create atmosphere and describe characters/settings. They will also be carefully considering their SPAG when writing. In Maths we will explore perimeter and area, multiplying and dividing 2 digits by ½ digits and we will continue to look at fractions. Children will learn how to solve word problems and improve their number fluency.
